## TICKETING AND SEATING

To protect your health we have social distancing measures in place for seating, and tickets are only available to purchase as singles or doubles. We have restricted the number of tickets available.

A Service NSW QR code will be available at the entry to each venue.

We recommend that you install the Service NSW app on your device.

Please arrive early for the concert to allow yourself time to register with our Front of House staff for contact tracing purposes.

Seating is unreserved, however, please be patient upon arrival as our ushers will direct you to the best available seats depending on your type of ticket.

Only patrons who have purchased double tickets will be permitted to sit together.

You can either print out your email confirmation as proof of purchase or show the email on your device to our staff.

## PROTECTING YOUR HEALTH

Masks are highly recommended whilst inside the venues, and will be available at the door should you need.

Bach Akademie Australia will ensure the church is sanitised before performances in accordance with NSW Health Guidelines.

Please practise social distancing at all times, and avoid gathering in groups on the footpath before and after performances.

Consider downloading the CovidSafe App.

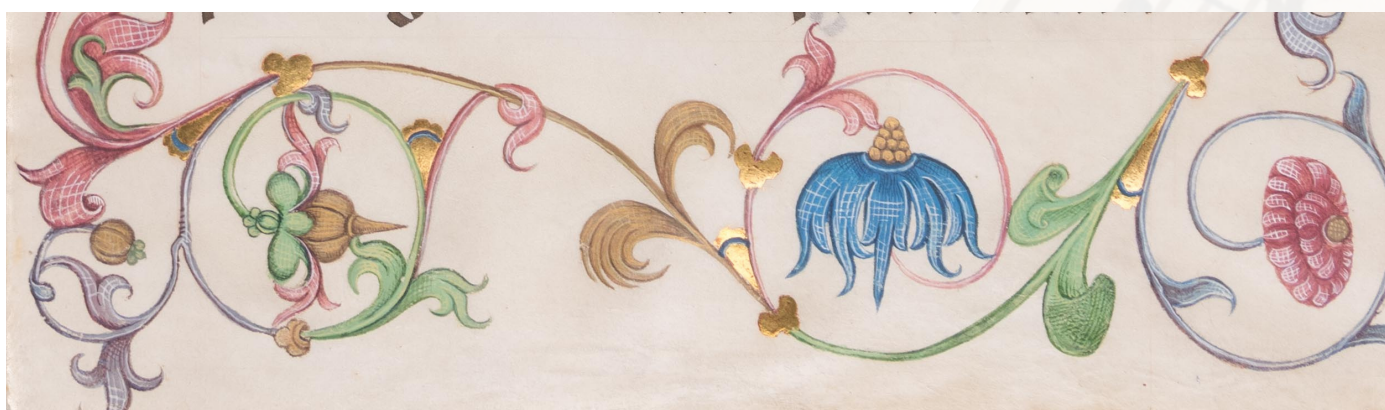
# ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES IF YOU ARE UNWELL

- have just returned from overseas or a hotspot area

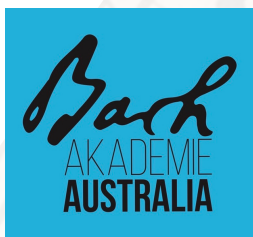
In any of these cases, we will offer you a full refund on your ticket purchase, including the booking fee.
